ISSUE STATEMENT: The City hired Mackenzie, the architect firm who is designing the proposed new police station, to review the concept of adding an annex behind the current police station and remodeling the interior of the current police station. Working with staff, Mackenzie developed two concepts for the annex including cost estimates for both concepts. The cost for the proposed new station was also updated. The work session tonight will review those concepts and ask for Council input as to which direction the Council would like to proceed and the potential timing for that direction.

BACKGROUND: The architect was asked to do concept plans for an annex behind the current police station to see if that could be a viable alternative to building a new police station. The concepts would include the potential layout of the annex and the current station and the estimated costs. The City could then compare the annex concept to building a new separate station. The presentation tonight will discuss: 1) a one-story annex; 2) a two-story annex; and 3) the updated costs for the police station at the corner of 19th and Birch.

The architect is finalizing the presentation for staff review. The presentation will be sent to the Council prior to the meeting if it is ready.
