1. CALLED TO ORDER:

A. TVC-Art Pass Leina'ala Voss-Ms. Voss holds the marketing & development position for Tualatin Valley Creates. She presented an overview of opportunities and services provided by TVC, tvcreates.org. We were encouraged to participate in ART Pass program. For a fee of \$25.00 members receive a discount at participating art venues throughout Washington County.

B. Open Aire Gallery Call for Art – The Library site was approved for the “7 Generations” sculpture. A ‘Cedar sphere’ by Josh Blewett was proposed for the flagpole site but was put on hold. Although this piece would enhance the PAC collection, it was deemed inappropriate for this site. The search will continue.

C. Mural Festival Artist Selection – Two previously selected artists are Emily Lux for WoodFold Marco and Marcie Kreibel for the Library. The selection committee gave their 4 top recommendations. Ursula Barton was selected to produce the mural on the Pizza Schmizza wall. Her piece will include community participation with the final illustration overlay yet to be decided. Dana will contact Egypt Hagan and Arturo Villasenor to resubmit their renderings as site of Bard Park will require a special application onto the

proposed Sports Court. Dana will call a special meeting of PAC for Thursday, January 27th at 5:00 to share her information from Anne Lane and the artists.
