3. CONSENT AGENDA:

5. DISCUSSION/DECISION/PRESENTATION ITEMS:

A. Featured Artist Collaboration with Pacific: Subashini Ganesan's Class at Pacific, "Arts Marketing and Advocacy", selected 5 local artists for this project. Arturo Villaseñor, Elise Wahl, Philip Thias, Maggie Pike and Mary Jane Nordgren were selected for the first phase. Each artist will be interviewed with a 3 -5 minute video showcasing their art. The Pacific class will make a formal presentation on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 from 6:30-8pm, place yet to be determined. The public will be invited to this presentation. Leslie, Dana, and Kathleen will plan the May 17th celebration along with Subashini.

B. Mural Fest - artist update: Ursula Barton's rendering was presented and critiqued. Dana will meet with the artist to share PAC's concerns. Marcie Kriebel presented several quotes to accompany her art work. She has not submitted her final drawing.

C. Open Aire - Base discussion: The Seven Generations sculpture will have smaller figures on the bottom and will increase in size with an 8 inch figure on the top. Dana and Colleen will research various bases and costs.

D. URA 2023 plan: Approximately 28 K is remaining in the present URA budget. It was decided that PAC will present a plan and timeline to encumber these funds.

E. Print Day: PAC was given a 2'x2' particle board to create a print. Dana and Leslie will explore which power tools will be appropriate for this project.

6. INFORMATION / UPDATE ITEMS:

A. Finance Report: Commission members are encouraged to give a leadership gift to PAC.

7. B/C COMMUNICATIONS: Linda Taylor shared information regarding the carriage rides that will occur during the Mural Festival celebration, Sunday September 18, from 12:30-4:30. 8 free 20 minutes tours will be given in a horse drawn carriage. Linda and Amy have graciously volunteered to lead the tours.

8. STAFF COMMUNICATIONS: Colleen reports that there will be a LIVE book sale the first weekend in June. Patrons have been very generous providing used books for this purpose. She also reminded us that the City is requiring all live meetings to also include ZOOM.
